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


CASE DEFINITION

Suspected case: A person with a cough lasting at least 2 weeks with one of the following: Paroxysms i.e. bouts of coughing; or Inspiratory "whoop" or Post-tussive vomiting (i.e. vomiting immediately after coughing) and without other apparent cause.

Or

A case diagnosed as pertussis by a physician.








GENDER WISE DISTRIBUTION






















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











Diseases with number of cases between 100 & 1000


