1. Provide strategic vision and oversight to the relevant provincial strategies and plans for child survival;
2. Work as a Technical Advisory Group to develop and finalize the design of Child Health related projects/pilots and new initiatives
3. Serve as a forum to share experiences and lessons learnt to guide future plans reinforcing complementarities and synergies as well as avoiding duplication;

4. Serve as a forum to share the results of midterm & end term evaluations of projects/programs related to child survival
5. Review and approve tools, guidelines and manuals related to child health
6. Provide a platform for sharing information, tools, and guidelines on child health including evidence-based best practices nationally and internationally;
7. Map on-going researches in child health and provide a forum for researchers to share research process and results;
8. Support ongoing efforts toward building a coordinated, effective health care delivery system for children
9. Help strengthen and support implementation of facility / community based child health programs using evidence based interventions.
10. Review and approve M&E frameworks for child survival including recording / reporting / monitoring tools in the context of alignment with existing monitoring system and inclusion in DHIS.
11. Advocate for and advise on ensuring the availability of needed commodities for child health services, including adequate budgeting, efficient supply management and encourage/ promote national production (please refine this in coordination with our partners).

The Child Survival TWG will meet every two months and a broader review meeting twice a year. A calendar of meetings will be developed by the Secretariat and approved by the group during its first meeting.
